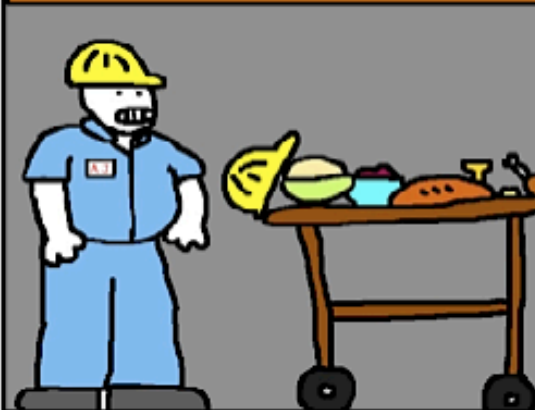
A BOOK I'D DEFINITELY READ IS A
